SPECIFICATIONS FOR HURRICANE SHUTTERS

- 1. Shutters may be installed as allowed by Florida statute.
- 2. Unpainted steel or aluminum panels cannot be covering any opening (doors, windows, patio doors, etc.) for more than 30 consecutive days.
- 3. The only protection that can be put up for a period longer than 30 consecutive days, during hurricane season (June 1 December 1), must be clear panels or (white/off white) panels either removable, roll up or manifold.
- 4. Hurricane membrane material, such as that made by 3M, cannot be dark or colored to noticeable change exterior color of windows.
- 5. The Board of Directors of St. Andrews must approve any other protective material.

UNIT OWNERS RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Prior to installation a "Request for Exterior Modification" must be submitted for approval to the Board of Directors of the sub-association in which the unit is located.
- 2. Shutters must be installed as per manufactures instruction and applicable Sarasota County specifications.
- 3. The shutters must be maintained in a presentable and acceptable condition.
